**Parks**  
There are eleven parks located throughout Lincoln County. Each park is unique and has its own level of features. Some are even tied to greenways and water such as Betty Ross Park is adjacent to the South Fork River.

**Greenways and Trails**  
Lincoln County, local communities, and other project stakeholders are working together to develop a greenway plan that will feature a core segment of the Carolina Thread Trail, a fifteen county regional network of trails. Several counties in the region have already completed and are adopting similar trail plans.
