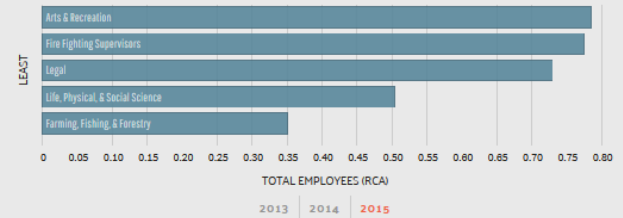
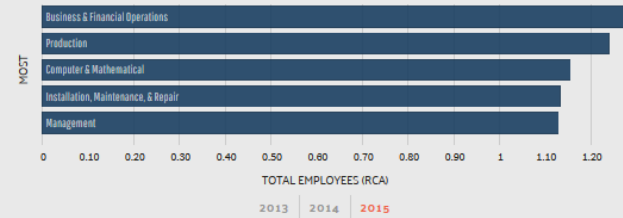
The most common jobs in Charlotte-Concord-Gastonia, NC-SC Metro Area by number of employees, are Administrative; Sales; and Management.

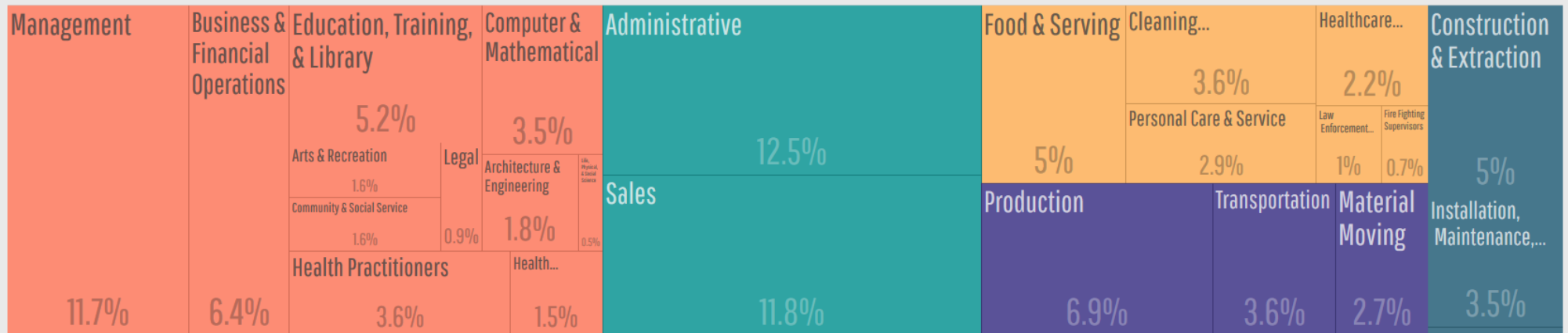

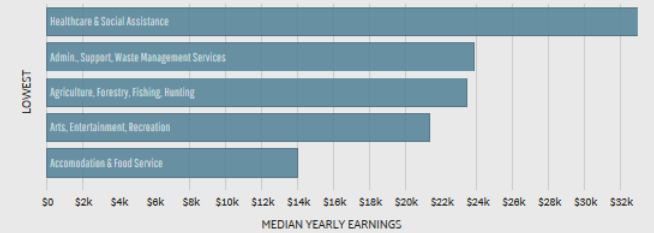
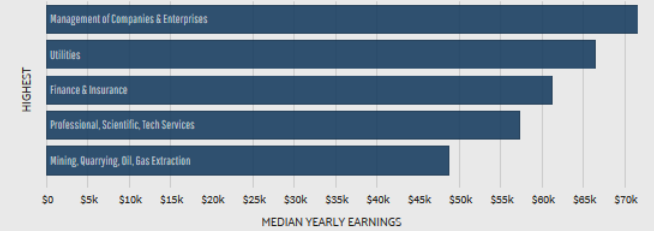

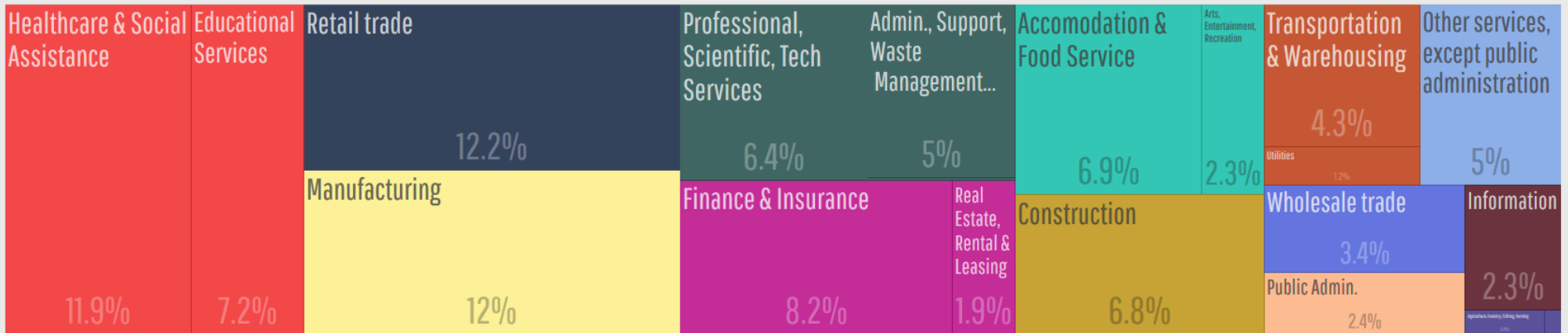
